

Notice under Regulation 5(7) of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice is hereby given that the Chairman of the relevant Improvement and Scrutiny Committee has agreed that part of the meeting of the Cabinet scheduled for can be held in private notwithstanding the fact that 28 days' notice has not been given, because the following items of business are urgent and cannot reasonable be deferred.

The following reports for the meeting will contain confidential information or exempt information under Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended) and that the public interest in withholding the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing it.

Reasons why the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred:

The Council is unable to publish details of the key decision 28 clear days in advance as this would delay the decision. A decision is required as soon as possible to enable the Council to protect its position and minimise and mitigate any ongoing financial costs and risks.
