Scheme

CHARITY COMMISSION

In the matter of the Charity known as Dr. Bland's Almshouses, in the Parish of Sandiacre, in the County of Derbyshire, founded by will proved with two codicils thereto at Derby on the 1st June 1909 as affected by a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners of the 29th April 1949; and  
In the matter of the Charities Act 1960.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established as the Scheme for the regulation of the above-mentioned Charity:-

S C H E M E

1. Administration of Charity. The above-mentioned Charity and the property thereof specified in the schedule hereto and all other the property (if any) of the Charity shall be administered and managed subject to and in conformity with the provisions of this Scheme by the body of Trustees hereinafter constituted.

2. Investments and cash. Subject as otherwise provided in this Scheme and to any further direction of the Charity Commissioners -  
(1) All investments now or at any time belonging to the Charity, not already standing in the name of the Official Custodian for Charities shall be transferred to the said Official Custodian;  
(2) All sums of cash now or at any time belonging to the Charity, other than sums of cash needed for immediate working purposes, shall be invested in the name of the said Official Custodian.

TRUSTEES

3. Trustees. The body of Trustees shall consist when complete of five competent persons being  
Four Ex-officio Trustees and  
One Nominative Trustee.

4. Ex-officio Trustees. The Ex-officio Trustees shall be -  
The Rector of the Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Giles, Sandiacre,  
The Chairman and the Vice Chairman of Sandiacre Parish Council,  
The member of Derbyshire County Council who represents the Parish of Sandiacre,  
all for the time being and by virtue of their respective offices.
