Complaints received pursuant to the Code of Conduct for Elected Members

1. Purpose of the Report

To provide a summary of the complaints received and their respective outcomes in relation to the Members Code of Conduct for the period 12th April 2019 to 21st June 2019.

2. Information and Analysis

As part of the procedure for managing complaints received in relation to the Members Code of Conduct, the outcome of any complaint received should be reported to the Standards Committee.

During the period 12th April 2019 to 21st June 2019, three complaints have been received and one of these has been concluded. At the time of the last update report, one complaint was outstanding and this has now been concluded and is reported below.

Cllr 1 (outstanding complaint from the last reporting period)	Member of the Public	Allegation that all aspects of the Code of Conduct had been breached due to disrespectful behaviour	Complaint not upheld
Cllr 2	Member of the Public	Failure to respond to repeated requests for information relating to a local issue	Complaint upheld in an informal manner as the Councillor in question offered an apology.

The Council is required to publish a Member Code of Conduct and a complaints procedure.
