Children's Services Capital Allocations 2022-23 S106 (Cabinet Member for Education)

1. Divisions Affected

1.1 County-wide

2. Key Decision

2.1 This is a key decision because it is likely to result in the Council incurring expenditure which is, or savings which are significant having regards to the budget for the service or function concerned (this is currently defined as (£500,000) and it is likely to be significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more electoral areas in the County.

3. Purpose

- 3.1 To inform Cabinet of the receipt of recent Section 106 developer contributions and to seek approval for the allocation of those contributions to projects in line with the individual Section 106 agreements.
- 3.2 To inform Cabinet of any time limited unexpended S106 receipts which in line with the S106 agreement need to be returned to the developer and to seek approval for the repayment of these receipts.

4.1 Appendix 2 details the S106 contributions that have been received by the Authority and any funds that require to be repaid. The Appendix details the schools that are to benefit from the investment, together with the planned projects.

6.1 Developer contributions are to be utilised as per the S106 agreements. If we did not allocate these contributions the funding for additional school places related to the growth in housing would have to come from Basic Need in order for the Authority to meet the statutory requirement for provision of school places.
