Action Plan Overview

Aligned with the overarching Strategy, the Action Plan sets out actions for each of the five key themes:

1. Local Authority Estate, Operations and Services
2. Strengthening the Low Carbon Economy
3. Decarbonising Derbyshire's Housing
4. Sustainable Transport, Travel and Infrastructure
5. Waste and Resources

Also a series of actions related to offsetting and communication and engagement.

Criteria for Action Development

- Where the greatest impact is likely, in terms of carbon and cost reduction and wider co-benefits
- Where the potential positive impact is maximised through councils working collaboratively
- Where there are shared pressures, targets and ambitions
- Where there is a real or potential market failure
- Where wider partnership working and influence is needed

- Renewable and Low Carbon Energy
- Planning
- Housing Retrofit
- Electric Vehicles
- Waste Behaviour Change
- Tree Planting



Next Steps

- Mapping exercise to establish existing activity and to inform the development of delivery plans.
- Vision Derbyshire Climate Change Officers Group will, for many actions, have a coordinating, influencing and oversight role.
