Measuring Success

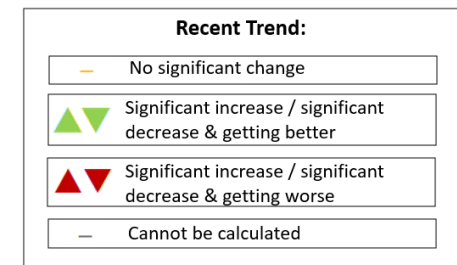
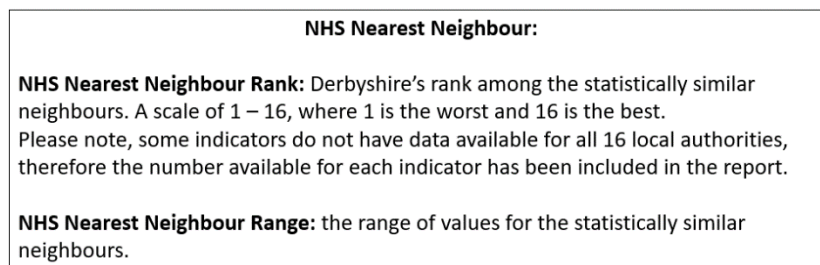
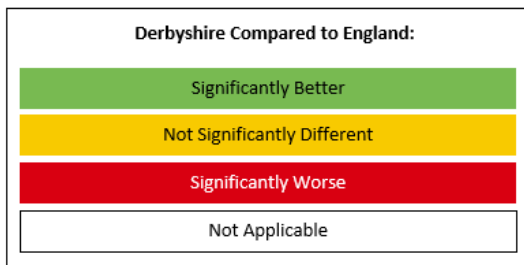
To understand our progress towards achieving key targets across the four Areas of Focus we will track a number of indicators over time using a Health and Wellbeing Strategy Dashboard. A wide range of indicators will be available through the dashboard, and a number of key indicators that we will track are presented below.

Recent Trend is calculated by Fingertips based on the five most recent data points.

The report uses the NHS Nearest Neighbour model to compare Derbyshire’s performance to 15 local authorities that are statistically similar to Derbyshire. The change in comparators in this report follows OHID’s decision to use the NHS model in Fingertips for the latest geography version (Counties & UAs (from Apr 2023)).

Please note that for some indicators on OHID Fingertips, the denominator source has been updated from the 2011 census population estimates to the 2021 census population estimates.
