**48/20 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** Councillor J Atkin declared a personal interest in relation to the application referred to in Minute 52/20 below (Agenda Item 3(1)) as a member of the Peak District National Park Authority and Derbyshire Dales District Council, which had both been consulted on this application.

**49/20 DECLARATIONS OF SIGNIFICANT LOBBYING** All members of the committee declared that they had been lobbied in relation to Agenda Item 3(1) in the form of several written submissions to them from members of the public via emails, in advance of the meeting.

**50/20 MINUTES RESOLVED** that the minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 5 October 2020 be confirmed as a correct record.

**51/20** <u>MATTERS ARISING</u> Proposed <u>development and operation of a</u> 18 megawatt renewable energy centre and associated infrastructure, through gasification at the site of the Drakelow 'C' former power station, Drakelow applicant: Vital Energy. Code No: CW9/0420/7 (Minute 44/20 refers) It had been suggested at the meeting of the Committee on 5 October that HGVs for use in the development should meet the most recent European environmental standards for HGV. The Head of Planning Services confirmed that this could not have been required by condition, given that there would be many HGV movements in the locality that would not be attributable to the development. He anticipated that through further liaison with the operator, it would be encouraged to adopt best environmental practice in its use of vehicles.

CODE NO: CM3/0817/40** The Head of the Planning Service explained that following the publication of the report on the application, statements had been received that raised further criticisms of the application and associated material, and that the planning service needed further time to carry out checking and investigation as to whether they were sufficiently addressed under the report.

A motion was proposed for the Committee to resolve to defer its consideration of the application.

Members suggested that a deferral would also be advantageous if it could allow a visit by members to the locality of the site to be arranged to take place before whichever committee meeting the application was consequently reported to.
